Educational Purpose

The purpose of this trip is for our students to experience once-in-a-lifetime performance opportunities, as well as serve as cultural and musical ambassadors. Performances in Hawaii will include the Kapolei Choral Festival (in which Conestoga is the first mainland choir to perform in the history of the festival), a band/orchestra performance on the U.S.S. Missouri in Pearl Harbor, and a special performance by the Wind Ensemble and Camerata at the Pearl Harbor U.S.S. Arizona Memorial. Cultural experiences will include a trip to the Polynesian Cultural Center, exploration of local wildlife and ecology, introduction to local Hawaiian music, and a tour of Pearl Harbor.

School Days Missed

Students will miss two days of school during the trip (4/6 and 4/7). Their teachers will be notified ahead of time, and students are responsible for all work missed during their absence for the trip.

Health Insurance

Students will carry their own health insurance during the course of the trip.

Trip Insurance

Trip interruption insurance is included in the price, and trip cancellation insurance is available from the vendors listed on the attached form.

Code of Conduct

All school rules are in effect during the trip, and the Conestoga Code of Conduct will be enforced for all student behavior. This is indicated on the field trip form signed by students and their parent/guardian.

Chaperone Supervision

Students will be assigned to a chaperone for the duration of the trip, and will have that person's contact information at all times. There will be times during the course of the trip when students will not be under the direct supervision of a chaperone (ex. in hotel rooms), however adults will be accessible at all times. Students are responsible for informing chaperones of all unusual incidents during the trip.
