## Drum Major Audition Requirements

### **All candidates must meet the following requirements:**

1. Must be a veteran member of the Marching Pioneers with at least two years experience.
2. Must be able to attend a drum major & leadership camp at WCU during the summer.
3. Must not be involved in any sport or activity which conflicts with band.
4. Must be present for the entire two weeks of band camp.
5. Must be able to attend **ALL** Marching Pioneer events.
6. Must have a clean school record with regard to drugs and/or alcohol

### **The audition process will include the following:**

1. A conducting excerpt to demonstrate 2/4, 3/4, and 4/4 patterns
  - a. An informational drum major meeting will be held on Thursday, April 26<sup>th</sup> at 2:30 pm to teach the patterns and pass out music.
  - b. Conducting will be evaluated based on correct patterns, clear beat, and stylistic elements
2. Demonstrate proper marching technique:
  - a. Attention
  - b. Parade Rest
  - c. Marking Time
  - d. Roll Step
  - e. 8 to 5 marching
  - f. Backwards march
3. Commands
  - a. Detail, atten. hut
  - b. Band horns up
  - c. Mark time mark
  - d. Band halt
  - e. Band parade rest
4. Personal interview with the marching band staff (to be scheduled later)
