

Tri-M Points

After acceptance into the Tri-M Music Honor Society, the student must have completed and submitted a minimum of 150 points by April 27, 2015. (PLEASE INCLUDE NAME AND DATE OF EACH ACTIVITY/EVENT). Non-listed music activities are negotiable with Music Faculty approval.

A minimum of 35 points must be achieved through service activities (approved by the Music Faculty).

5	Attend a PMEA or community concert
5	Attend functions at other Tri-M chapters
5	Design a Music Dept. bulletin board
5	Assist with music "meet & greet" or other special function
5	Assist with music office tasks
10	Organize a performance to benefit a charity, community, or non-profit organization
5	Audition for the PMEA District Festival
15	Participate in a PMEA District, Region, and/or All-State Festival
10	Participate in a music dept. public relations activity
5	Perform in a CHS Concert (maximum of 50 points for Marching Band)
5	Perform a <u>substantial</u> solo in a CHS Concert (subject to Mrs. Dickinger's approval)
10	Perform at a school function (i.e. open house, course selection, awards night)
10	Perform in a mini-concert at a retirement home, mall, hospital, etc.
5	Perform in church or temple (maximum of 30 points)
5	Provide singing telegrams on special occasions to school faculty, administration, etc.
25	Solo recital performance (at least 30 minutes)
10	Perform with outside select groups (i.e. PYO, DCYO) - maximum of 30 points
10	Serve in a leadership or service capacity in any of the CHS performing groups
10	Take part in a "Music in Our Schools Month" activity (March)
5	Take, develop, and turn in pictures from any school music event
5	Usher at a TE School District music function
5	Tri-M Recital performance
10	Write a 3 - 5 page music-related paper
